### Job Description:

We are seeking an individual to work in a fast paced, demanding environment, servicing automated driveway gates at residential, commercial, and industrial sites mostly in and around Bay and Walton County. Also, to maintain and repair access control and automatic gate systems, which includes: keypads, card readers, remote receivers, telephone entry systems, gate operators and electric locks, of all makes and models. We also provide mechanical repairs to drive gates (slide and swing) pedestrian gates and doors. Service techs are expected to diagnose problems, communicate clearly with customers about the nature of the problem and possible solutions, order parts, and return to the site to make the necessary repairs. Job info, scheduling and notes are recorded through cloud-based software. Ability to perform some heavy labor is required: cutting of concrete and asphalt, digging, running conduit, pulling wire, pouring concrete, and hanging heavy gates. *Some relevant experience required.*
